Everyday goodness

If we stop to look around our neighbourhood, we can be surprised by the everyday goodness in people. Our local turf, cluttered and messy as it may be, is holy ground. Yes, there are always the ordinary hassles of daily living, but hidden amongst them is a rich soil in which goodness can grow and blossom.

Have you noticed the citizen who shops for the elderly or the person who helps a child solve a problem? Then there's the neighbour who listens patiently to the struggles of others, or the person who works for justice. In all of these ways, God's kingdom is being raised up.

The building up of that kingdom involves the whole of life, not just the part connected with church. As we listen to Jesus' words about giving to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's, we could be forgiven to think our lives have two separate parts. But that would be to misunderstand the message. It would foster an unhealthy dualism. In the Jewish way of looking at life, an understanding shared by Jesus, everything belonged to God.

There wasn't a worldly realm and God's realm, it was all one. Like us, Jews believed that God is present in every aspect of life, including the world and the universe. We can't separate our lives into a secular compartment and a religious compartment. Nor should we drive a wedge between the worldly body and the otherworldly soul, as if spirituality is about escaping from the flesh and seeking the spirit. It doesn't work like that, even though there are times it might seem convenient.

We live in a world where there is much sadness and injustice, and everything we do to alleviate this is part of the building up of God's kingdom. The world that we live in desperately needs the transforming power of the gospel of love to help it heal.

When we reach out to the poor, the outcasts, and those who are rejected and when we bring goodness and kindness to those around us, we are doing our best to give God all of our lives, every aspect of them. In other words, our work, homes, classrooms and neighbourhoods, are all places in which we can bring our spirituality to bear.

So, we take hope from those who bring release to people held captive in fear, or who reveal new possibilities of life to those who have been crushed. We resolve to be part of this work because we believe that all of life is holy, and God is at work throughout all of creation and in the life of everyone. Everything belongs to God, even Caesar's coins!
